CHANGES	No additions, changes or refunds on day of the meet. Only scratches will be accepted.

TEAM PACKETS

A packet pick-up table will be stationed by the entrance to the track. Coaches or a team representative are responsible for packet pick-up.

ADMISSIONS

The admission fee is \$3.00 for adults and \$1.00 for Children 4 to 12. Athletes will use wrist bands for free admission. All coaches must show a valid 2008 USATF or AAU membership card for free admission.

COMPETITION

Meet management reserves the right to combine divisions and heats for a single race where numbers allow. Separate awards will be presented.

The top eight fastest times advance to the finals.

Events with eight or less entries will be contested as a final.

Events will be contested youngest to oldest, girls then boys, unless otherwise notes.

AWARDS

Medals: 1st thru 3rd places

Ribbons: 4th thru 6th places

Team awards will be given to the Coach or a representative of the team at the end of the meet.

TENTS

Tents are allowed on the top row of the stands and around the stadium.

PRACTICE FIELD

A practice area will be provided for all athletes. A cooling tent will also be provided.

SPORTS MEDICINE

Trainers from **ATHLETICO** will be on site and available to all participants.

PARKING

Free parking is available in all of the parking lots on the school premises.

Take 88 East to 294 South and follow above directions (From the North)
